Bob & Karen Meyer began raising registered quarter horses in 1973 when we took in a band of mares and a stallion belonging to a friend, Lee Lopez. We split the foal crop the first year, after that we decided we should have a horse sale. Geno & Effie Hunt were our sale partners in the early years (Effie was Lee's sister). Jeff and Jim Hunt were also in the sale at times, we remain good friends. It was very interesting and we met many people who became friends that made it fun over the years, but we have decided it is time to let someone younger continue raising foals. Lee Lopez is also selling his last two mares.

The mares are selling as exposed, they have been with the stallions all summer. They are not preg-tested. There is no live foal guarantee or any return breeding privileges. They are all halterbroke and gentle, some more so than others. We worm them twice a year, but other than that they do not receive any special care. They run out on pasture year-round, we give them hay in the winter usually starting around the end of December—depending on snow cover, and make sure they have access to water, salt, and mineral. Most are foaled out in the barn/corral so they are gentle and used to being handled. The stallions are all broke to ride and are nice to be around. We usually hand breed some mares early in the season and then turn the stallions out sometime in May. Many of the mares that sell are ones that have been born on our ranch. They carry the bloodlines of stallions we have used : Drop Of Frost, Docs Willow, Fixers Crystal Brick, Gringo Pistolero, Starlights Lenny. The foals have all been caught 3 or 4 times. They have been eating plain whole oats for about 6 weeks. They were all wormed in early July.

Lynn Weishaar has been the auctioneer for 41 years and knows our horses well, as does John E. Johnson. Feel free to contact them, if anyone has questions about our horses, phone numbers on the inside front cover.

We appreciate everyone who has bought a foal from us throughout the years and especially those who went on and used them in an event or on the ranch. It is always fun to get a report on how they are doing. We wish continued success with the sale to Denny & Doris Lauing, Glen & Janet Long and their invited reputable consigners who will have a sale, same date, in Faith in 2019.

Star Struck Dun It was shown in AQHA Reining earning 39.5 Points, Working Cowhorse 21 Points and Halter .5 Point. He is also a money earner in NRHA, NRCHA, Barrel Racing and has heeled a few vsteers. He has a nice disposition with a very smooth way of moving and is easy to handle. He is trained to be collected on the dummy. Last year was the first time he had ever been pasture bred and turned out in barb wire. He is easy to catch out in the pasture and he accepted mares added later to his band after he was turned out. When we bring the mares home, we halter him and he leads beside the UTV at a fast trot. Hollywood Dun It is in the NRHA Hall Of Fame and was the first reining horse to sire earners of over \$6,000,000. He is on the Equi-Stat list of All Time leading Sires of Reining and Reined Cowhorses. Starleenic is the producer of earners of \$22,068 National Reining Horse Association.

Grays Starlight was on the Equi-Stat List of top 3 Leading Sires of Cutting and Reining Money Earners with a total of \$6,884,981. He earned \$41,307 NCHA and was also a Leading Reined Cowhorse Sire.

The highest bidder is to be the buyer. We urge all buyers to thoroughly examine any prospective purchases prior to the sale. If any dispute arises between two bidders, sole authority to settle the dispute as he sees fit is reserved by the auctioneer, and his decision shall be final. The auctioneer reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

Terms of the sale are cash or personal check. All Canadian buyers must pay in US funds or equivalent. Persons wanting to bid by telephone on sale day must make arrangements prior to the sale and have a minimum bid of \$500 per lot received by Faith Livestock Commission before August 31st.

Horses are the buyer's expense, risk, and responsibility from the time of purchase, but no delivery will be made until final settlement has been made. The buyer must make arrangements for the care of their horses if they are not taken on sale day.

All registration papers will be held by the sellers until all checks clear the banks—normally about two weeks. If any buyer wishes to obtain the papers on sale day, they must pay in cash or certified check. The papers will be then mailed to the buyers and the buyer will be responsible for the transfers.

Health certificates will be issued for transportation purposes on sale day by the sale Veterinarian, Dr Ford. Horses will all be Coggins tested unless announced differently before that lot is sold. Broodmares are selling as "exposed", they have been pasture bred and are assumed to be in foal, but there is no guarantee and no return breeding privileges. A registration application for each of the 2019 foals will be sent on to the buyer as soon as they are issued by AQHA.

Anyone who is interested in buying a saddle horse and wants to ride it before the sale must make arrangements with the seller to do so prior to the sale. Only the sellers will be riding their horses on sale day at the sale barn and fair grounds. Any guarantees are strictly between seller and buyer.
